



Fundas Autofluorescence (OPTOS)

While all tests and services provided to our patients are approved by Health Canada, it's important to note that some tests are not covered by OHIP and are therefore uninsured.

Please be aware that declining any or all uninsured tests and services suggested by our care team will not affect the medical treatment you receive at North Toronto Eye Care.

Although these diagnostics and services may not be considered medically essential, the valuable images and data obtained from your eyes play a crucial role in tailoring your treatment plan.

Optical coherence tomography, known as OCT, is a diagnostic technique utilized to produce an image of the retina. This non-invasive method creates an image by quantifying the level of reflected dim red light from your retina and optic nerve.

In contrast, the OPTOS fundus autofluorescence test delivers a high-definition depiction of the complete retina, utilizing filters capable of penetrating the tissue. Due to the exceptional clarity of these images, this test identifies various retinal diseases much earlier than OCT imaging.
