



Intraocular Lens Master Testing (IOLM)

While all tests and services provided to our patients are approved by Health Canada, it's important to note that some tests are not covered by OHIP and are therefore uninsured.

Please be aware that declining any or all uninsured tests and services suggested by our care team will not affect the medical treatment you receive at North Toronto Eye Care.

Although these diagnostics and services may not be considered medically essential, the valuable images and data obtained from your eyes play a crucial role in tailoring your treatment plan.

All patients undergoing cataract assessments will receive an Ascan ultrasound of the eye, fully covered by OHIP.

The Ascan is crucial in cataract surgeries, as it helps our ophthalmologists determine the power of the intraocular lens (IOL) required for the procedure.

While not medically necessary, the Intraocular Lens Master (IOLM) employs laser technology to precisely gauge the eye's length.

Accurate measurement of eye length is crucial for cataract surgery, enabling surgeons to choose the most suitable lens for implantation.

Compared to the ascan, the IOLM has demonstrated superior accuracy, furnishing additional data that enhances precision in lens selection for surgery. This heightened accuracy often diminishes the post-surgery dependence on glasses in numerous cases.
